SUBJECT: Hurricane Lee: Suspension of Binding Authority

Environment Canada has issued various weather warnings regarding the expected track of Hurricane Lee. Hurricane Lee will be moving through New Brunswick and Nova Scotia bringing heavy rain, high winds and large waves to the area. Forecasters expect the storm to make landfall by Saturday evening.

Facility Association is **suspending** binding authority on the addition of physical damage coverage (Collision, Comprehensive, and/or Specified Perils) applicable to all vehicles insured through the Facility Association Residual Market, where such vehicle does not already carry physical damage coverage, located in the following counties:

- Charlotte County
- Saint John County, including the City of Saint John
- Albert County
- Westmorland County, including the City of Moncton

This suspension will be in effect from **12:01** am **September 16**, **2023** until **12:01** am **September 18**, **2023** and applies to new business and endorsements, not limited to vehicle additions or substitutions.
