SUBJECT: Update: Suspension of Binding Authority

Effective immediately Facility Association is **reinstating** binding authority on the addition of physical damage coverage (Collision, Comprehensive, and/or Specified Perils) applicable to vehicles insured through the Facility Association Residual Market, where such vehicle does not already carry physical damage coverage, in the following areas:

- Ingraham Trail
- Jean Marie River
- Kakisa
- N'Dilo
- Yellowknife

Suspension of binding authority remains in place for new business and endorsements, including vehicle additions or substitutions in the following areas:

- Dettah
- Enterprise
- Forth Smith
- Hay River

SUBJECT: Wildfires: Suspension of Binding Authority

The Government of Northwest Territories has declared a territorial state of emergency in response to the threat of multiple wildfires.

Effective immediately Facility Association is suspending binding authority on the addition of physical damage coverage (Collision, Comprehensive, and/or Specified Perils) applicable to vehicles insured through the Facility Association Residual Market, where such vehicle does not already carry physical damage coverage, in the following areas:

- Dettah
- Enterprise
- Forth Smith
- Hay River
- Ingraham Trail
- Jean Marie River
- Kakisa
- N'Dilo
- Yellowknife

This suspension applies to new business and endorsements, not limited to vehicle additions or substitutions.

The suspension of binding authority will be in effect until further notice.
