SUBJECT: New Brunswick Wildfires: Suspension of Binding Authority

Effective June 5, 2023, Facility Association is **reinstating** binding authority on the addition of physical damage coverage (Collision, Comprehensive, and/or Specified Perils) applicable to all vehicles insured through the Facility Association Residual Market, where such vehicle does not already carry physical damage coverage, located in the following areas:

- Postal Codes beginning with 'E5B'
- Saint Andrews and Bocabec

This reinstatement of binding authority applies to new business and endorsements, not limited to vehicle additions or substitutions.

SUBJECT: New Brunswick Wildfires: Suspension of Binding Authority

The Province of New Brunswick is actively monitoring a fire in the area of Saint Andrews, New Brunswick.

Effective immediately Facility Association is suspending binding authority on the addition of physical damage coverage (Collision, Comprehensive, and/or Specified Perils) applicable to all vehicles insured through the Facility Association Residual Market, where such vehicle does not already carry physical damage coverage, located in the following areas:

- Postal Codes beginning with 'E5B'
- Saint Andrews and Bocabec

This suspension applies to new business and endorsements, not limited to vehicle additions or substitutions.

The suspension of binding authority will be in effect until further notice.
